Including Western Union, Orlandi Valuta and Vigo Agent locations, Western Union has a network of more than 44,000 Agent locations spanning over 40 countries and territories in the region. In addition, bill-payment services are offered at more than 5,200 Pago Facil locations in Argentina.

Money Transfer

Western Union offers a variety of ways for consumers to send funds to friends and loved ones, including:

- In person at more than 44,000 Agent locations throughout the region, including more than 17,600 Agent locations in Mexico;
- Online at westernunion.com and over the phone via 1-800-CALL-CASH® from the U.S. to most countries in the region.

Western Union also offers consumers a variety of options in sending and receiving funds, including:

- The "Money in Minutes" option;
- The "Next-Day" delivery option;
- The "Direct to Bank" option, which enables consumers to send funds from the U.S. to a qualifying Mexican or Brazilian bank account;
- The option for receivers to direct funds to a stored-value card, debit card or money order in select countries;
- Home delivery of funds with Western Union and/or Vigo in select countries.

Bill Payment

Western Union allows consumers in Argentina to:

- Send cash payments for public services and taxes and pre-pay for Internet access and mobile phone top-up at more than 5,200 Agent locations through Western Union subsidiary Pago Facil.

Recent Launches:

- In the fourth quarter of 2008, Western Union announced the launch of Western Union Pago De Servicios, a walk-in cash bill payment service in Peru that will allow Peruvian consumers to pay for services such as mobile phone service and utilities.
